n 2024, RADPAC raised \$797,002 from 2,011 contributors. RADPAC had 59 "Outstanding Practices" participating in a group contribution.

Other highlights include RADPAC hosting 7 fundraising events for Members of Congress raising more than \$100k, attending more than 150 fundraising events for Members of Congress, and coordinating more than 15 visits by Members of Congress to radiology practices.

RADPAC's visibility and impact on Capitol Hill remains at an all-time high. It is critical that RADPAC maintains this status as radiology continues to face many legislative challenges ahead including, but not limited to, fair reimbursement, cancer screening coverage, scope of practice, larger Medicare reform initiatives, workforce issues and GME residency slot funding.


